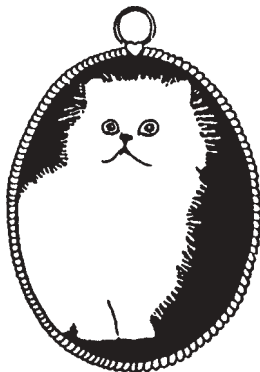

## DEFINITION OF CLASSES

<b>OPEN CLASS</b>	Open to all of the specified breed. (Must be GCCF registered.)
<b>CATS</b>	Not less than 9 calendar months on the day of the show.
<b>KITTENS</b>	Not less than 14 weeks and under 9 calendar months on the day of the show. From 1st June 2001 Council have agreed that neuter kittens will be entered in kitten open and miscellaneous classes and will compete for BIS kitten. Neuter kittens of preliminary breeds will be included in kitten assessment classes where separate class for Adult, Kitten & Neuter are scheduled.
<b>NEUTER ADULTS</b>	Neuter adults may only enter neuter classes and may not compete with entire cats or kittens except in Club Classes which are scheduled to include Neuters. Where Best in Show is held, the best Neuter shall be considered against the best Entire Adult and Kitten for Best Exhibit in Show.
<b>NOVICE</b>	Exhibits that have not won a First Prize in any class at a show held under GCCF Rules.
<b>LIMIT</b>	Exhibits that have not won more than four First Prizes in any class at a show held under GCCF Rules.
<b>DEBUTANTE</b>	Exhibits that have never been shown at a show held under GCCF Rules. (If Debutante Adult and Neuter classes are offered at a show, entry as a Debutante kitten does not count when the exhibit is shown as an adult or neuter, and entry as a Debutante adult or kitten does not count when the exhibit is neutered and shown.)
<b>MAIDEN</b>	Exhibits that have not won a First, Second or Third prize in any class at a show held under GCCF Rules.
<b>BREEDERS</b>	Exhibits bred by exhibitor/s. Cats originally registered in the breeders' joint ownership but changed to single ownership of one of the breeders can still be entered in this class. Cats originally registered in Breeder's single ownership and changed to joint ownership with the Breeder should be entered in the Non-Breeders Class.
<b>JUNIOR</b>	Cats over 9 calendar months of age and under 2 years on the day of the show.
<b>ADOLESCENT</b>	Cats over 9 calendar months of age and under 15 calendar months on Show day.
<b>SENIOR</b>	Cats 2 years old and over on the day of the show.
<b>ARISTOCRAT</b>	Cats that have won at least one Challenge or Premier Certificate, but not Champions or Premiers.
<b>ASSESSMENT</b>	For Experimental breeds only, entrants may also enter the appropriate Miscellaneous and Club Classes. Entries must include a standard of points which has been approved by the GCCF.
<b>RADIUS</b>	For cats and kittens living under 25 miles from the show hall.
<b>VISITORS</b>	For cats and kittens living over 25 miles from the show hall.
<b>CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS / PREMIER OF PREMIERS</b>	To be entered in these Classes, the cat must be a full Champion or Premier. The cat may also enter into its appropriate Open Class
<b>IMPERIAL Gr Ch &amp; IMPERIAL Gr Pr</b>	To be entered in these classes the cat must be a full Grand Champions and Grand Premiers. The cat may also enter its appropriate Open OR Grand class.

The status of the exhibit for entering restricted classes (ie Maiden, Limit, etc) shall be the cats' status on the day of entry, except where Section 2, Rule 15e regarding entry into Grand Classes applies. The

wins as a Kitten do not count when the exhibit is shown as an Adult or Neuter; the wins as an Adult do not count when the exhibit is neutered and shown. Merit Awards do not count as 'wins' for entering restricted classes.

**Notes:**

- (1) To be eligible for entry into the Grand Champion or Grand Premier Classes, the status of Champion or Premier must be attained on or before the closing date for entries as published in this schedule
- (2) When counting wins / prizes, include all awarded in any class at a show held under GCCF rules.

All wins previous to the midnight preceding the day specified in the Schedule for close of entries shall be counted when entering classes.

No kitten may be entered into any Adult Class unless specified for Cat or Kitten.

### **SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS**

The show is held under Licence and Rules of the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy and is open to all. A copy of the Rules may be obtained from the GCCF Offices, 5 King's Castle Business Park, The Drove, Bridgwater, Somerset TA6 4AG. Ignorance will not be accepted as an excuse for a breach of the Rules.

There will be no overnight penning. Cats will be received at the entrance to the Show Hall on Show Day from 8am to 9:45am.

Each exhibit must be examined by one of the Club's Hon. Veterinary Surgeons before being penned, and all unfit exhibits must be removed from the Show Hall by their owners and the entry fee forfeited, and if, in the opinion of the Veterinary Surgeon, it is desirable, all other exhibits from the same cattery shall be debarred from attending the Show. **THE VETERINARY SURGEON'S DECISION IS FINAL.**

Exhibitors whose cats have been debarred from the Show please note the following points:

1. When sending your clearance certificate to the Veterinary Officer, please include your copy of the rejection slip.
2. Please **DO NOT** send these certificates by recorded delivery as this can cause considerable delays in the receipt of your certificates. If you wish to satisfy yourself that your letter has reached the Veterinary Officer please enclose a stamped, addressed postcard for acknowledgement of receipt, and this will be signed and returned to you.
3. Exhibitors should not attend Shows until they have received a letter from the Secretary confirming clearance. It is recommended that this letter be taken to Shows within a month of the issue of the clearance letter.

All exhibits must be accompanied by their owner or representative, and must be transported in a suitable container. No exhibit will be accepted on a lead only. The owner, or representative, must be within call at all times.

Exhibitors are responsible for the correct description of their cats, and for entering them in the correct classes. Entry forms must be signed by the registered owner/s of the exhibit and will be forwarded to the Show Manager, together with the correct fee(s). **NO TELEPHONE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Exhibits must enter each cat in at least **THREE** classes in the Pedigree Section (except Exhibition only classes). No exhibit may be entered in more than **SIX** classes including the Open Class.

A Benching Fee is included for each cat in its entry fee.

Each exhibit must be entered in **THREE** classes, one of which must be an **OPEN** class. For Experimental breeds granted Preliminary recognition by the GCCF exhibitors must provide a copy of the approved standard of points **WITH THEIR ENTRY**, and state **NAME OF BREED AND COLOUR** on the entry form.

Every exhibit must be provided with a white sanitary tray and water bowl and clean, plain white or near-white blanket or blankets, without distinctive marking or edging, which may be arranged in such a manner as to assist the comfort of the cat. Cellular blankets are not allowed, but Vet-Bed or like material with white or green backing may be used if preferred. Hot water bottles are the only form of heating allowed, provided they are covered by the blanket in accordance with GCCF Rules. The use of any other form of heating will result in disqualification. All exhibits must have water, but food containers must be removed when judging commences at 10am and may not be returned until 1pm.

Judges are instructed to pass any pen that is distinguished in any way. No stud advertisements, or written or printed matter of any kind, other than official award cards and rosettes may be put on pens. Exhibition pens may be decorated, and **ONLY** these may carry printed matter relating to the exhibit.

No exhibitors may remove official notices from any cat's pen.

Prizes will be paid from the Judges award slips and not from the Catalogue.

- (a) REFUSE ANY ENTRY WITHOUT GIVING A REASON
- (b) Refuse admission to the Show Hall without giving a reason
- (c) Retain a percentage of the entry fees to cover essential expenses in the event of the Show being cancelled for any reason.
- (d) Retain entry fees if a Cat is withdrawn after closing date.

The minimum age for entry of a kitten is 14 weeks.

No person may remove any exhibit from its pen except the owner (or owners representative should the owner not be present at the show) or a club official. No cat may be removed from the Show Hall prior to the closing time of 5.00pm, unless permission for early removal has been given by the Show Manager.

Cats with unregistered parents but which are themselves registered (on June 1st, 1971) and which are eligible for Challenge Certificates on that date shall continue to be so and so shall their suitable progeny for three generations from 20th October, 1971. Thereafter, only cats with registered parents, grandparents and great-grandparents shall be eligible. All pedigree cats, kittens or neuters exhibited at a GCCF Show must be registered. All registered exhibits which have changed hands must have been transferred to their new owners at least 21 days before the Show. All registrations and / or transfers must have reached the GCCF 5 KING'S CASTLE BUSINESS PARK, THE DROVE, BRIDGWATER, SOMERSET TA6 4AG at least 21 days before the form, write N.A.F. (Number Applied for) in the appropriate column and forward the number as soon as possible to the Show Manager. You must NOT write NAME APPLIED FOR in the column for 'Name of Cat' but give your first choice of name in this column.

All correspondence must be accompanied by a self-addressed stamped envelope or postcard if a reply is desired.

The GCCF Rules that no cat or kitten from the same household or cattery may be entered in two Shows taking place within 13 days, whether or not such cat is actually exhibited at either Show.

Any complaint about this show must be received in writing by the Show Manager within seven days of the Show.

An announcement in 'Our Cats' of any alteration or addition made to this schedule shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.

Exhibitors are reminded that all Club Specials are confined to fully paid-up members of that club, and they should ensure that they have paid their subscriptions for the current year, to avoid disappointment. PRIZES / ROSETTES will be awarded at the Show on the understanding that in the event of disqualification, these awards will be returned on demand to the Show manager by the recipient. Failure to comply with such a demand will render the exhibitor liable to Disciplinary Action by the GCCF.

Note: NO SPRAYS OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED IN THE HALL. The pen may be wiped down with a little cotton wool dampened with any non-toxic disinfectant before placing the exhibit in it.

#### **GENERAL NOTES FOR THE GUIDANCE OF EXHIBITORS**

- (a) If your exhibit is rejected by the examining Veterinary Surgeon before or during the Show, the GCCF will require you to produce a certificate of freedom from infection as indicated in Rule 4, before being permitted to attend or exhibit at any future Show. This certificate must be dated not less than seven days after the Show at which the exhibits were rejected, except in the case of rejection for skin lesions indicative of Ringworm Infection, when a certificate indicating that the cats were not suffering from Ringworm on the date of the Show must be dated not more than seven days after the Show at which the exhibits were rejected, and these certificates should be submitted to the GCCF Veterinary Officer together with relevant details. The address of the Veterinary Officer is printed on the rejection form that you will receive should your cat be rejected.
- (b) If you have any cats or kittens at an address other than the one given on your entry form, or at an address other than your own, the relevant facts should be submitted to the GCCF. This is in order to safeguard you and others in case of apparent evasion of the 13 day Rule.
- (c) Evasion or breach of any GCCF Rules, or the Articles of its Constitution, may, and often will, result in Disciplinary Action, and you are advised to familiarise yourself with all of the Rules.

(d) Except where the context demands otherwise, the 'CAT' includes Kittens and Neuters. A kitten is defined as being a young cat under 9 months of age. Thus, a Kitten born on the 12 January becomes a Cat on the following 12th October.

All exhibits must be inoculated against Feline Infectious Enteritis FVR & FCV (Cat Flu) the full course in accordance with manufacturers recommendations must have been completed 7 days before the show. The Certificate must have been issued by a Veterinary Practice / Hospital and the last vaccination entry signed by a Veterinary Surgeon or by a listed Veterinary Nurse under the direction of a Veterinary Surgeon. This should be properly completed and clearly indicate the identity of the exhibit and the owner, confusion may result in rejection. Cats without valid certificates will be rejected under Section A, unless the exhibitor undertakes to provide proof of vaccination by sending the certificate to the GCCF office within 7 days of the show. Failure to do so will lead to disqualification from the show and the cat's name will be placed on the veterinary rejection list until proof of vaccination is received in the Office.

**ALL CURRENT CERTIFICATES MUST BE AVAILABLE FOR VETERINARY INSPECTION IF REQUIRED.**

**THE GCCF RECOMMEND THAT ALL CATS AND KITTENS OWNED BY EXHIBITORS BE REGULARLY TESTED FOR FELV. CATS SHOWING A POSITIVE REACTION TO THE FELINE LEUKAEMIA VIRUS BLOOD TEST OR THE FELINE IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS BLOOD TEST MUST NOT BE SHOWN.**

PLEASE NOTE: Homeopathic vaccination is not acceptable for the purpose of showing.

#### **NOTES - ASSESSMENT CLASSES**

The exhibits in these classes are now eligible for other classes. They will not compete for 1st, 2nd etc in Assessment Classes, but will be individually assessed by one judge who will award a merit at his/her discretion. These cats are eligible to enter Miscellaneous Classes.

Exhibitors must provide a copy of the Standard of Points approved by the GCCF for the use of the Judges, together with the entry form, and name of the Breed on the Entry Form.

#### **ADDITION TO RULE 6, Note 1, Section II (Show Management)**

In the event of a change of judge of an Open Class after the closing date of the show, and provided that the exhibitor informs the Show Manager prior to judging that a certificate has previously been awarded by the replacement judge, the Show Manager shall appoint one other judge who shall judge the cat and if the cat is considered worthy, countersign the certificate which shall then count towards championship status.
